The Varkey family had left Kerala, India to seek a better life for their family. What they found was a real need to educate children arriving in the city from around the world. The academic program is rooted in the core curricula of language and literature (English and Arabic), mathematics, integrated sciences and individuals and societies. This core is enriched by specialist courses in language acquisition, the arts (including visual art, music and drama), physical health education, and design. Learning is often organized through 'inquiries' that transcend traditional subject areas to develop deeper understandings and a wider array of skills. Through the formal curriculum and other activities throughout the day, our students will learn, display and eventually embody the attributes of the IB Learner Profile.

The IB exhibits every facet of an ideal system of standards, curriculum and assessments. It is a passport to the finest universities in the world, and is a qualification that challenges and inspires students to become caring, meticulous and disciplined thinkers. In delivering the IB we give our students statistically the best possible chance of gaining places in top universities. The IB was created in the latter part of the twentieth century in order to create a curriculum that provides for the modern world. It is based on modern understandings of how students learn and how best to support that learning. The curriculum helps foster a culture at GEMS International, which recognizes the importance of positivity, the importance of developing students so that they learn how to succeed, and the importance of understanding that failure is only a temporary state on the road to further success and development.


We chose to place our children in the GEMS International School because it offers the IB curriculum and boasts modern and excellent facilities. The school offers diversity among both teachers and students and we love that!



## The Primary Years Program

The International Baccalaureate® (IB) Primary Years Program (PYP) is a curriculum framework designed for students aged 3 to 11. The PYP at GEMS International School prepares students to become active, caring, lifelong learners who demonstrate respect for themselves and others, developing the capacity to be 'inwardly strong and outwardly looking' thus participating in the world around them. It focuses on the development of the whole child as an inquirer, both within and beyond the classroom. GEMS International School develops students' academic, social and emotional wellbeing, focusing on international-mindedness and strong personal values. The PYP nurtures independent learning skills, encouraging every student to take responsibility for their learning.

The program incorporates local and global issues into the curriculum, asking students to look at six related, transdisciplinary themes and to consider the links between them. The themes include 'who we are', 'where we are in place and time' and 'how the world works'.



We love the interactive nature of the IB curriculum, which gives our children a broad range of questioning and curiosity skills about the world around them in partnership with academic capability. The teaching staff are very engaged and always open to discuss ways to help the children learn effectively. # Essential Elements in the Primary Years Program

## The 5 essential elements of the PYP are:

- Knowledge, which is both disciplinary, represented by traditional subject areas (language, mathematics, science, social studies, arts, personal, social and physical education) and transdisciplinary;
- Concepts, which students explore through structured inquiry in order to develop coherent, in-depth understanding, and which have relevance both within and beyond subject areas;
- **Skills**, which are the broad capabilities students develop and apply during learning and in life beyond the classroom;
- **Attitudes**, which contribute to international-mindedness and the wellbeing of individuals and learning communities, and connect directly to the IB learner profile;
- **Action**, which is an expectation in the PYP so that successful inquiry leads to responsible, thoughtful and appropriate action.

Through assessment, teachers identify what students know, understand, can do and value at different stages in the teaching and learning process.

In the PYP, learning is viewed as a continuous journey, where teachers identify students' needs and use assessment data to plan the next stage of their learning.

Teachers use a wide range of assessment strategies to collect information on each of the elements represented in the written curriculum: the understanding of concepts, the acquisition of knowledge, the mastering of skills, the development of positive attitudes and the ability to take responsible action.



## Encouraging In-Depth, Collaborative Inquiry

In the final year of the PYP, students carry out an extended, in-depth, collaborative project known as the PYP exhibition.

This involves students working collaboratively to conduct an in-depth inquiry into real life issues or problems. Students collectively synthesize all of the essential elements of the PYP in ways that can be shared with the whole school community.

It also provides teachers with a powerful and authentic process for assessing student understanding.

The exhibition represents a unique and significant opportunity for students to exhibit the attributes of the IB learner profile, developed throughout their engagement with the PYP.

It also provides schools and students with a wonderful opportunity to celebrate the transition of learners to the next phase of their education.



## The Middle Years Program

The Middle Years Program (MYP) is a challenging framework that encourages students to make practical connections between their studies and the real world.

The MYP curriculum framework comprises eight subject groups, providing a broad and balanced education for students in Grade 6 to Grade 10.

In the final year of the program, optional MYP eAssessment provides IB-validated grades based on examinations and course work. Students who undertake external assessment are eligible for IB Course Results and the IB MYP Certificate.

The MYP is open to any student aged 11 to 16 and is inclusive by design; students of all interests and academic abilities can benefit from their participation.
